There will be a total of 11 pods assembled for export over the next few months, totaling around \$120,000 worth of stainless.



Pacific, MO

Summerville, SC

slewing drives for large machinery such as wind turbines and cranes, relocated their German plant to South Carolina. They needed to install specific machinery with specific sizes (54mm and 28mm) that had been cut out of the German plant and shipped to South Carolina. Delk Plumbing Inc. of Summerville, SC, provided Viega ProPress stainless fittings in sizes to match and installed approximately \$11,000 in pipe and fittings. Memphis, TN
